Chimney-stacks all but one lopped off and replaced with unsightly flue-pipes. No uniformity of exterior décor, doors and windows of all different types and colours,



Chimney-stacks removed on both sides, slates replaced with concrete tiles, lower windows all shapes and sizes.



And again chimney-stack removed on the right, all brick or stonework covered in concrete render, slates replaced with concrete tiles, upper window aperture altered in middle house. The entire row gutted of all original features.
